

Quest Academy Nut-free Policy

A child in our community has a life-threatening peanut allergy. Because of the seriousness of this allergy and our commitment to ensuring the safety of every student, we are converting Quest Academy into a nut-free school.

- No peanuts, peanut products, tree nuts, or tree nut products, can enter the school.
- No foods that contain peanuts, peanut products, tree nuts, or tree nut products can enter the school.
- No foods that are made on equipment that also processes peanuts, peanut products, tree nuts, or tree nut products can enter the school.

Having only non-allergenic foods in the classroom lowers the risk of contact exposures via contaminated common surfaces and objects.

Actions we take to support food allergy safety every day:

- Teach children and adults to wash hands upon arrival, before eating and after eating
- Teach children that all bodies are different and families send lunch foods that work for each child — therefore we do not share lunch foods
- Post reminder signs
- Post safe snack list on bulletin board in foyer

We are here to support each other. In helping our students with life-threatening allergies, we all work a little harder with our own food so that everyone can be safe. If you need help or advice in following these guidelines, please ask — help is here.
